Towage

With our tugboats we provide towing provision during mooring, de-mooring, shifting and other movement of vessels, sea towing of vessels and other floating objects, towage and handling of deck barges for the transport of plant modules and heavy equipment combined with RORO and lift on and off operations.



Heavy Lifting

In the marine offshore and civil construction sectors, as well as the lifting and positioning of structures with a wide variety of modules, we offer flexible solutions to ports, shipyards, offshore facilities and civil projects, integrated all transport and installation activities by means of floating crane and barges.



Oil & Gas

Conductor and wellhead platforms with pipe line installation

Well conductors are used as the foundation and structural support for topsides and, depending on size and water depths up to 50 meter, are fully installable by our ICE-I-100 hammer and crane barge LEAD Marlin. Minimizing the size of traditional conventional jackets reduces lead times for material and construction, allows for fabrication at our Trinidad & Tobago yard facility, which further reduces overall project costs, significant shorter times, and where required, improve project local content. To connect oil production platforms with refineries onshore we provide reel-lay pipe and cable lay services accomplished by a typical pipe laying/cable lay heavy lift crane barge with anchor spread system.



Offshore Civil Construction

For specific offshore construction of bridges, wharfs, cruise ship terminals, ports, jetties, yacht marinas, dredging, bulkheads and quay walls we can supply and provide crane barges, transport deck barges, tugs and piling hammers for the structural steel pipe piling operations.



Marine Salvage

Today, protecting the coastal environment from spillage of oil or other contaminants due to a ship wreck or other maritime casualty is a high priority. Salvage may encompass diving, towing, re-floating of a vessel, or effecting repairs to a ship. For these operations we provide pre-outfitted salvage tugs and crane barges, and in addition we partner with salvage and diving companies for expertise and portable diving facilities and mobilize all resources swiftly to the salvage site.



Facility & Storage

Our facility is located at LP6 First Avenue Granwood, Western Main Road, Chaguaramas, Trinidad, West Indies where we encompass combined open yard storage and secured warehouse facility. The property comprises 144,936 sq.ft of open yard space and roadways most suited for staging and equipment storage. Our covered warehouse facility allows for 12,000 sq.ft (60 ft x 200ft) of secured protected space. We have adequate water and electrical supply with sufficient lighting and 24/7 security. This facility is an excellent premises which forms the perfect auxiliary support for any transit and offshore service. Overall we aim to provide a holistic product to adequately meet the requirements of all our local and international customers.
